Joint Resolution requesting the State Roads Commission to take over and improve as a public park an area of approximately one acre of land, belonging to the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, lying between the old and new approaches to the Chester River Bridge in Queen Anne's County, at Chestertown.

WHEREAS, in the construction of the approach to the Chester River Bridge in Queen Anne's County, at Chestertown, the State Roads Commission left an area between the old road and the new road; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the vicinity purchased the entire property and conveyed the same to the Board of County Commissioners and the said Board subsequently conveyed to the State Roads Commission a right of way which has been improved by a public road forty feet wide connecting the old bridge road with the new bridge road, and thereby leaving now owned by the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, a small strip of land between the new road running
