CHAPTER 210.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County", sub-title "Reports", said new section to be known as Section 465A, and to follow immediately after Section 465 of said Article, to regulate publication by the County Commissioners of Garrett County of statements regarding their annual levy.

CHAPTER 211.

AN ACT to add seven new sections to Article 83 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Sales and Notices", sub-title "Fair Trade Act", said new sections to be known as Sections 115 to 121, inclusive, and to follow immediately after Section 114 of said Article, making unlawful the unfair trade practice of selling goods at less than cost.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That seven new sections be and they are hereby added to Article 83 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Sales and Notices", sub-title "Fair Trade Act", said new sections to be known as Sections 115 to 121, inclusive, and to follow immediately after Section 114 of said Article and all to read as follows:

115. It shall be unlawful for any person engaged in commerce, in the course of such commerce, to sell, offer for sale or advertise for sale any article, product or commodity at less than cost thereof to such vendor, or give, offer to give or advertise the intent to give away any article, product or commodity for the purpose of injuring competitors and destroying competition, or to advertise brands or types of goods they are not prepared to supply, provided, however, that nothing herein shall
