

*Diseased Dogs.* For the owner of any dog with a contagious or infectious disease to permit such dog to stray from his premises.

*Female Dog in Season.* For the owner of any female dog to permit such dog to leave his premises excepting on a leash while such dog is in season.

*Dead Dog.* For any person to deposit or knowingly to leave his dead dog on public property or the property of another.

*Concealing a Dog.* For any person to deny ownership or possession of or to conceal or harbor any dog on which the license fee has not been paid, or to conceal a dog suspected of rabies to keep it from being impounded for observation and possible destruction.

*Alteration of License Certificate.* For any person, for an unlawful purpose, to alter the original entries on a license certificate.

*Unlawful Use of Lost Tag.* For any person to use a lost tag for which a duplicate has been issued or to use a tag on a dog for which it was not issued.

*Purchase of Fraudulent License.* For any person to purchase a dog license on fraudulent representations concerning himself or the dog licensed.

*Counterfeiting of License Tag.* For any person to use a tag in substitution for a legal license tag so similar in shape and appearance that it is easily mistaken for the official tag for the current year.

*Kennel License Liability.* For any person financially interested in a kennel license to permit any unlawful operation or practice by such kennel.

*Failure to Use Kennel Identification Marks.* For any person to take dogs from a kennel as provided in Section 256B without wearing identification marks as required by said section.

*Failure to Keep Records of Kennel or of Pet Shop Sales.* For the owner or operator of a kennel or pet shop to fail to keep a substantially complete record of all dogs kept at a kennel or pet shop and of essential data concerning sales or other disposition of dogs delivered from kennels or such shops.

*Denial of Identity or of Ownership.* For any person to deny his identity to a Warden or other enforcement agent in order to escape service of a summons or warrant of arrest or of replevin for a dog.

*Unlawful Removal of Tag.* For any person, except the owner or custodian, to remove a legally acquired license tag from a dog, excepting in case of distress or injury requiring the temporary removal of the collar or harness.
