(d) They shall provide for the inspection and cleanliness

of all privies, yards and stores;

(e) They shall regulate the location, inspection and cleaning of dairies, stables, cow-yards and pens, all factories and other places of business likely to be or become detrimental to health, and shall maintain a good sanitary condition in the streets, public places and buildings;

(f) They shall have full power to regulate or prohibit the dumping of refuse in said Town or the maintenance of dumps.

(g) They shall provide for the frequent inspection of all premises by a person or persons to be designated by the Mayor or health officer:

- (h) They shall pass such ordinances as they may deem necessary to preserve the health of the Town, suppress and remove all nuisances, prevent the sale of adulterated or decayed food, and prohibit any and all business within the corporate limits as shall, in their opinion, injuriously affect the sanitary condition thereof.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts, general or local, inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1937.

CHAPTER 257.

AN ACT to authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County to issue refunding bonds of the County for the purpose of refunding outstanding bonds of the County maturing between June 30, 1937, and June 30, 1939, and to provide for the payment of such refunding bonds and interest thereon by the levy of taxes upon all taxable property in the county; to validate such outstanding bonds; and to provide that this Act shall be passed as an emergency measure.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County be and the said Board is hereby authorized and empowered to issue at one time or from time to time refunding bonds of said County in an amount not exceeding \$693,000
