

390C. The County Commissioners of Wicomico County shall provide the sheriff and his chief deputy with an office at the Court House and shall furnish all fuel and light needed for the county jail and said office.

390D. The County Commissioners of Wicomico County are hereby directed, authorized and empowered to make provision by appropriation in their annual levy from year to year for sufficient funds to pay the salaries and expenses hereinbefore provided for.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That if any section, paragraph, clause, sentence or part of this sub-title for any reason be adjudged to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this sub-title, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, sentence or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgments shall have been rendered.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1939.

CHAPTER 271.

AN ACT to amend the title "Old Age Pensions", following after Article 70A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement) by striking out said title and inserting in lieu thereof a new title, to be known as "Old Age Assistance"; to repeal Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 7A, 7B, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 20 of said Article, and to insert in lieu thereof twenty-two new sections, to be known as Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22, to provide for public assistance to aged persons in need, and the administration thereof.

CHAPTER 272.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 421A to 421M, inclusive, of Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Harford County", sub-title "Liquors and Intoxicating
