- 346. The Treasurer shall be entitled to appoint such clerk or clerks as he may deem necessary, and for whose official conduct he shall be responsible; said clerk or clerks to be paid by the Treasurer out of the salary provided by law to be paid him as compensation for the discharge of his official duties as the collector of taxes, but in addition thereto the County Commissioners may in their discretion allow and pay over to said Treasurer for additional clerk hire an amount not to exceed in any one year the sum of Four Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$4,200.00).
- 356. The Treasurer of Prince George's County shall receive in full compensation for the discharge of his official duties as collector of taxes levied for State and County purposes the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) for each year of his term of office, which shall be payable monthly; and shall receive no other compensation for the collection of any taxes whether for State or County purposes.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1937.

## CHAPTER 285.

- AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 200 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer" as said section was amended by Chapter 458 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1935 increasing the compensation of the Court Stenographer of Prince George's County.
- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 200 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer", as said section was amended by Chapter 458 of the Acts of 1935, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:
- 200. The Judges of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County are hereby authorized and directed to appoint an official court reporter for said court, who shall be an expert stenographer, shall be a sworn officer of said court, shall hold
