tion, shall appoint the number of County School Commissioners, the several counties shall be entited to; Provided, that if the district school trustee should not meet and furnish the names from which to make selection, as provided by this Section, by the first of June of this year, and the first of June every two years hereafter, then the State Board shall appoint such number of Commissioners as the county may be entitled to from amongst its citizens most distinguished for interest in the subject of Education, and most likely to promote the success of the school.

Section —. The District School Trustees, or County School-Commissioners are hereby authorized to take the affidavit or affirmation as the case may be, from the teachers as to the correctness of their quarterly report.
