The bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 35 of the Acts of 1874, entitled an Act to add an additional Section to Article 4 of the Code Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," to be known as Section 871 A, and re-enact the same with additional Sections to be known as Sections 871 A and 871 B.

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill an Act to repeal Section 82 with its Sub-Section 1 to 4 inclusive, and Sections 83, 84, 85 and 87 with its Sub-Sections 1 to 13 inclusive of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick county," sub-title "Frederick," as enacted by the Act, passed at January Session, 1872, chapter 348, and to enact substitutes therefor and in lieu thereof.
