Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to amend Article 13 of Public General Laws, Maryland Code, volume 1, title "Bastardy and Fornication," in Sections 1 and 4, by striking out the word "white," whenever it appears, and to re-enact the same with an amendment.

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 21 of Article 38 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," sub-title "Notaries Public," and to re-enact the same with an amendment.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled an Act for the prevention of Intemperance among the young men of Maryland.

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 1, of Article 67, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Notaries Public," as amended by the Act of 1872, chapter 191, and to reenact the same with amendments.
