A bill entitled an Act to repeal ch. 466 of 1870, entitled an Act to distribute the Academic and High School Fund of Carroll county, to the Western Maryland College and Manchester Academy, in Carroll county, and to enact a substitute therefor,

Was read a first time and referred to the Carroll delegation.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to amend Art. 75, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Pleadings, Practice and Process," by adding to the same two Sections, rendering equitable defences available in actions at law,

Was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to add an additional Section to Art. 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the City of Baltimore, sub-title "Taxes and Loans," as sub-Section 873, A,

Was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 56, of an Act, passed at the January Session, 1866, title "Kent county," sub-title "Chestertown," and to re-enact the same with amendment.

Which was read a first time and referred to Messrs. Boyer, Usilton and Sprigg.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Harford county, to refund to the Executor of Edward Painter, late of said county, county taxes paid in error.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Harford delegation.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to amend Article 72, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Partnership Limited," by adding thereto a Section regulating the responsibility of persons not being partners, who shall receive or contract to receive a portion of the profits of any partnership, general or limited, as a compensation in whole or in part, for money loaned or services rendered thereto or therefor.
