Sec. 11, line 5, strike out the word "shall," and insert the word "may," in line 7, of Section 11, strike out the word "shall," and insert "may."

Sec. 11, line 9, after the word "dollars," insert "in the discretion of the Court."

The proposed amendments were severally read and adopted, and the bill, as amended, read a second time.

Mr. Fenton moved that said bill be read a third time this day under the provisions of the Constitution, Sec. 27, Art. 3.
