The Secretary of the Senate returned the following bills severally endorsed, passed by yeas and nays :

The bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 46, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed in 1874, relating to fencing in Worcester county, except so far as the same relates to the 1st Election District, and to enact the following in lieu thereof.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 32, of Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Centreville," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add additional Sections to said Article.

The bill entitled an Act to prohibit the granting of License for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at or near Washington Factory, in Baltimore county.

The bill entitled an Act to require the County Commissioners of St. Mary's county, to report annually to the Grand Jury of the September term of the Circuit Court for said county, a statement of the expenses of the county.

Also, returned,

The bill entitled an Act to prevent Hogs and Geese from running at large in and within two miles of the village of Urbana in Frederick county.
