A bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 65 of Article 35 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Elections," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to create a loan to discharge an indebtedness of the President and Visitors of the Maryland Hospital, now secured by mortgage of said Hospital and premises, and to provide furniture for the same.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to add a new Section to Article 26 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Corporations, so as to provide a more summary remedy against Companies incorporated by this State, with authority to transport persons or property for hire.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to regulate the fishing with seines in the waters of Bush river, Gunpowder river, Middle river or Back river, or their tributaries, situated in Harford and Baltimore counties.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Harford and Baltimore county delegations.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to require the Comptroller to revise the settlement heretofore made with Horace Resley, late Clerk of Allegany, and to pay to said Resley such amount as may be found due him in such revision.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Claims.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 2, of Article 37, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Evidence," subtitle "Competency of Witnesses," as enacted by chapter 385, of the Act of the General Assembly of 1874, and re-enact the same with amendments.
