Which was read and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Mr. Whitelock submitted the following order :

WHEREAS, There was a balance in the Treasury of the State of Maryland on the 1st February, 1876, of \$432,467.05, and on the 1st March, 1876, of \$194,738.08;

And whereas, At the first named date there was a balance of \$230,077.89 undeposited in bank, and on 1st March a balance of \$195,961.80 so undeposited;

And Whereas, The Constitution of this State requires the money of the State to be deposited by the Treasurer as soon as received,

Ordered, That the Treasurer report forthwith the place where the beforenamed sums of \$230,077.89 and \$195,961.80 were deposited at these respective dates, with the security given, satisfactory to the Governor for its safe-keeping and forthcoming when required.
