Sec. 7, line 4, after the word "holder" insert "member."

Sec. 8, line 1, insert the words "violating or," between the word "to" and the words "or failing."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Vandiver submitted the following amendment :

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

"And be it enacted, That the provisions of this Act shall not apply to Harford and Prince George's counties."

Which was rejected.

Mr. Hart submitted the following amendment :

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out, "That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage."
