No. 155. An Act for the better protection of birds and game in Wicomico county.

No. 156. An Act to incorporate the Stock Exchange of the City of Baltimore.

No. 157. An Act to add additional Sections to Article 21, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Washington county, in regard to horses and carriages kept at livery in said county.

No. 159. An Act to provide for the assessment and taxation of the property of railroad companies in this State, for county and municipal purposes, and to repeal all laws, or parts of laws, inconsistent with the provisions of this Act.

No. 160. An Act to encourage the killing of hawks, big owls, toxes and weasels, in the counties of Charles and Kent.

No. 161. An Act to authorize the residents of White Marsh Parish, in Talbot county, to make St. Paul's their Parish Church.

No. 162. An Act to commute the term of imprisonment of such prisoners in the Maryland Penitentiary as shall be found worthy.

No. 163. An Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Edward V. Morris, Tax Collector, for the 1st and 2nd districts of Caroline county, for the years 1872 and 1873, for money overpaid into the Treasury.

No. 164. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 1 and 3, of chapter 35, of the Acts of 1864, entitled an Act to incorporate the Methodist Episcopal Church at Port Deposit, providing for the election of trustees of said church.

No. 166. An Act to repeal Section 46, of Article 10, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, relating to the town of Cambridge, in Dorchester county, as amended by Act of 1872, chapter 175, and to re-enact the same in an amended form.

No. 167. An Act to amend the 4th Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding another Section thereto, in relation to investments on account of the sinking fund.

No. 168. An Act to protect fish in the waters of the Wicomico river from non-residents.

No. 169. An Act to repeal Sections 6, 8 and 21, of the Acts of January Session, 1872, chapter 54, entitled an Act to exempt all that portion of the waters of the Chesapeake Bay, lying northward of a certain line therein described, from the operations and effects of Sections 1 and 3, of Article 98, of the Cade of Rubic General Laws, title Wild Fowly and to enact other Sections to be in force and operation in, or and over said waters, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
