The bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Carroll county to adjust and settle the amounts due Jeremiah Robertson, Trustee of John Smith, John Smith's children, and George Kane, for county taxes paid in error; and to authorize the Comptroller of the Treasury to settle the State taxes on the basis adopted by the County Commissioners, and certified by them,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, in their discretion, to pay a sum of money not exceeding three thousand dollars, to erect a bridge over Wye River, in said county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an additional supplement to an Act, entitled an Act to incorporate the Trustees of the Particular Baptist Church at Black Rock, in Baltimore county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
