The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Comptroller to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for a sum of money sufficient to re-imburse Sprigg Harwood for money erroneously paid into the State Treasury, and to direct said Sprigg Harwood to pay the same, when so re-imbursed, to the County School Commissioners for Anne Arundel county.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays with proposed amendment."
