The bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Wm. T. Iglehart for work done for the Executive Department, by direction of ex-Governor Groome.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to make valid the bequest of Elizabeth Stansbury, to the Trustees of St. Paul's Reformed Church of Westminster, in Carroll county.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Thomas E. Evans, late Collector of Taxes of Baltimore county, money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury of the State.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Register of Wills of Washington county to transcribe certain records.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Comptroller to pay Nicholas Beard, of Washington county, the sum of fifteen dollars and sixteen cents, for money erroneously paid for taxes into the State Treasury, and to authorize the County Commissioners of said county to refund to him money improperly paid as county taxes.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to add an additional Section to Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to be known as Section 45 A.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Carroll county to adjust and settle the amounts due Jeremiah Robertson, Trustee of John Smith, John Smith's children, and George Kane, for taxes paid in error.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact several Sections of chap. 181, of the Acts passed at the January Session, 1874, which Act repealed Article 71, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Oysters."
