

A bill entitled an Act to empower the Clerk of the County Commissioners, for Talbot County, to administer an oath or affirmation to any account, to any person presenting a claim to the Commissioners against the county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Boyer, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act for the protection of Partridges, and Rabbits, and to prevent trespassing with dog or gun, on private property, in Kent county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Browning, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably.

A bill entitled an Act to regulate the fees of the County Surveyor for Garrett county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Dodson, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Talbot County Canal and Navigation company.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Gordy, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Wicomico county, to levy a sum of money for the support of William Benjamin Gordy, while in an Insane Asylum.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Browning, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to prevent Stock from running at large within the limits of Garrett county.

Which was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Loane,

The vote by which the bill entitled a supplement to an Act, January Session, 1860, chap. 267, to incorporate a Company to open a road from Frederick city, to Spout Spring, was ordered to be recommitted to the Frederick delegation, was reconsidered, and said bill, together with accompanying petitions, were referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
