The further consideration thereof was postponed, the bill ordered to be printed and made the order of the day for Monday, the 31st instant.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Consumers' Mutual Gas Light Company of Baltimore city,

Being upon a second reading,

On motion of Mr. Stewart,

The further consideration thereof was postponed, and said bill ordered to be printed.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Wicomico county to levy a sum of money for the support of William Benjamin Gordy while in an Insane Asylum,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a

third reading.

The bill entitled an Act for the protection of Partridges and Rabbits, and to prevent trespassing with dog or gun on private property in Kent county,
