A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Consumers' Mutual Gas-Light Company of Baltimore city.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Talbot County Canal and Navigation Company.

Which was considered.

Mr. Harig, Chairman of the Committee on Claims, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to refund to Dennis Cookson, of Carroll county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Waters, of Dorchester, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to approve an Act passed January Session, 1874, chapter 93, requiring the County Commissioners of Dorchester county to subscribe to the capital stock of the Cambridge and Chesapeake Railroad Company.

Which was read a first time.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 442, of the Act of the General Assembly, passed at January Session, 1872, relating to the shooting of wild fowl in the waters of Dorchester county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Bird, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to add additional Sections to Article 5, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Calvert County," sub-title "Taxes," providing for the appointment of a Treasurer and a more economical collection of taxes in Calvert county.
