Which was read a first time.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the bequest of George W. Johnson to the German Lutheran Evangelical Saint Mathews Congregation, of Baltimore.

Which was read a first time.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal the 12th and 13th Sections, of Article 75, Code of Public General Laws, and to amend and re-enact the same.

Which was read a first time.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to provide against fraudulent voting at elections.

Which was read a first time.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to legalize the revised Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, prepared by Lewis Mayer, Louis C. Fischer and E. J. D. Cross.

Which was read a first time.

Also, reported unfavorably,

A bill entitled an Act to add a new Section to Article 61, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Mechanics' Lien," to come after Section 53, and called Section 54.

The unfavorable report was adopted.

The Senate bill entitled an Act regulating the closing of roads in Prince George's county, with proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 6, after the word "of," the words "a majority of."
