A bill entitled an Act, to repeal an Act, passed at the January Session, 1874, chapter 506, entitled an Act for the Taxation of Dogs in the State of Maryland, so far as the same relates to Garrett county.

Which was read a first time and referred to Messrs. Barnard, Browning and Sprigg.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of making repairs and additions to the furniture of, and for procuring articles necessary for the uses of the Executive Mansion.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act for the Protection of Hotels and Boarding-House Keepers, and add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws, to be entitled Hotel and Boarding-House Keepers.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

Returned the bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Section 935, Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore."

Endorsed: "Passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments."
