The bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford county to divide any of the election districts in said county into election precincts, and to designate the places of holding elections therein,

The bill entitled an Act to repeal the Act passed at the January Session, 1874, chapter 439, entitled an Act to regulate the issuing of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in this State, so far as the same applies to Frederick county,

Being upon a second reading.

Mr. Ward submitted the following amendment:

Section 1, after the word "Frederick," insert the words "Cecil and Garrett," and make the word "county" read "counties."

The amendment was adopted,

And the bill, as amended, was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
