

property as is hereinbefore referred to, as well as all other, property, real, personal and mixed, of the said Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, within their several jurisdictions, not used for the purposes contemplated in the charter of said Company.

*And be it further resolved*, That, if upon such assessments, the said Company shall refuse, upon demand, to pay such taxes as may be payable upon such assessments, it shall be the duty of the several law officers of this State, and they are hereby directed to proceed to collect the same by due course of law.
