Which were severally read and adopted.

Mr. Purnell submitted the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

SECTION 2. *And be it enacted*, That ballots for or against such sale shall have printed or written on them the words "For Restricted License to sell Spirituous or Fermented Liquors, to be limited to Hotels," or "Against License for the Sale of Spirituous or Fermented Liquors;" and the ballots so cast shall be carefully counted by the judges of said election, and that said judges shall make a return of said votes to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Worcester county, and said Clerk shall immediately make proclamation of the result of said election.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That if it shall be found by said returns of judges of election, and proclamation of the said Clerk, that a majority of said votes have been cast against license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors, that then and in that event it shall not be lawful for any person or persons or body corporate to sell intoxicating, spirituous or fermented liquors, except cider and home-made wines, in said county, after the first day of May next, and all laws authorizing the same are hereby repealed; and any person violating the provisions of this Section shall, upon indictment and conviction therefor, be fined not less than one hundred dollars, nor more than two hundred dollars, and be imprisoned in the county jail ten days for each offence.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That if it shall be found by said returns of judges of said election and proclamation of said Clerk that a majority of said votes has been cast for restricted license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors, to be limited to hotels, that then and in that event all laws inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, and that the following Sections shall be added to Article twenty-two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, under the sub title "Sales of Spirituous or Fermented Liquors," to take effect on the first day of May next.

In Section 68, insert after the word "Act," in line 23, "which said bond shall be responsible to all such persons hereinafter described as may be injured by the sale of intoxicating liquor sold by persons licensed under this Act.
