Mr. Whitelock submitted the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 55 to 64 inclusive, of the Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, entitled "Collector;" and Sections 78 to 90 inclusive, entitled "Treasurer," be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following Sections, entitled "Treasurer and Collector," enacted in lieu thereof.

Amend Section 3, line 2, by adding after the word "law" the following: "To be administered by either of the Judges of the Circuit Court."

Amend Section 8, line 6, by striking out "eight," and insert "nine."

Amend Section 12, line 5, by inserting before the words "post-office," "supposed," so as to read, "supposed nearest post-office."

Amend Section 12, line 22, by adding after the word "interest," "and the execution of the deed from the Sheriff herein provided, and its production in any suit, or of a duly attested copy thereof, shall be prima facie proof of the regularity of the proceedings of said sale."

Amend Section 14, line 6, after "advertising," insert, "but if the amount so due shall be paid the Sheriff without sale, he shall be entitled to compensation, at the rate of five per centum on the amount collected, with such expenses as may be incurred in printing and advertising."

Section 16, line 3, after the word "Auditor," insert "who shall be the Chief Clerk to the County Commissioners."

Strike out of first line, Sec. 2d, "by the General Assembly of Maryland."

Make "Section 2" "Section 3."

Make "Section 3" "Section 4."

Make "Section 4" "Section 5."
