A bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 9 of Article 14, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act passed at January Session, 1852, entitled an Act to incorporate the Santa Clara Mining Association of Baltimore, authorizing said Association to make and enforce payment of all calls or assessments upon its capital stock heretofore made or hereafter to be made.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

The bill entitled an Act to extend the charter of the New York and Baltimore Transportation Line, which incorporation is, by virtue of the Act of December Session, 1847, chapter 112, passed January 18th, 1848, and the Supplementary Act passed February 7th, 1866, chapter 106, at a Session begun on the 10th day of January, 1866.
