

Also,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to make valid deeds and other instruments of writing defective in acknowledgments, or in the certificate thereof.

On motion of Mr. Jones,

Leave was granted to the Montgomery delegation, to introduce an Act to provide for taking the vote of the people Montgomery county, for or against the re-division of said county into twelve election districts, at the election to be held in the fall of 1876.

On motion of Mr. Hoblitzell,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to amend Article 4. of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding a new Section in relation to investments on account of the sinking fund.

On motion of Mr. McWilliams,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims, to introduce a bill to refund to Ross Winans the sum of seventy-eight dollars and thirty-six cents for taxes erroneously paid into the Treasury of the State.

On motion of Mr. Gill,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize the Potomac Bridge Company to borrow money and issue bonds therefor.

Also,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore city delegation, to introduce a bill authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, to issue city stock for the purpose of redeeming the five million loan known as the Baltimore Water Stock redeemable at pleasure, on and after the first day of May, 1875, and to provide for the payment of all taxes, State, Federal or otherwise.

On motion of Mr. McWilliams,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, chapter 291, of the Acts of General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January Session, 1860, which was an Act to incorporate the People's Gas Company of Baltimore city.

Also,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, of chapter 251 of the Acts passed at January Session, 1816, which is an Act to incorporate the Gaslight Company of Baltimore.
