Harmatall of to walnut gers Leave was granted to the Committee on the Juliciary, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to make valid deeds and other instruments of writing defective in acknowledgments, or in the certificate thereof.

Leave was granted to the Montgomery delegation, to introduce an Act to provide for taking the vote of the people Mont omery county, for or against the re-division of said county into twelve election districts, at the election to be held in the fall of 1876.

On motion of Mr. Hoblitzell,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to amend Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding a new Section in relation to investments on account of the sinking fluid.
