A bill entitled an Act to preserve and define the harbor of Salisbury, and the channel of Wicomico in Wicomico county.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 476, of the Acts of 1870, entitled an Act to provide for the creation and regulation of incorporated Companies in the State of Maryland, and to enact a substitute therefor.

Returned the bill entitled a supplement to the Acts, incorporating the Western Maryland Railroad Company, and conferring new powers on said Company.
