Leave was granted to the Baltimore city delegation to introduce a bill to repeal Sections 1 and 2, of chapter 401, passed January Session, 1874, of the Code Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Courts," and reenact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill entitled an Act to pay Horace Resley a sum of money paid into the Treasury erroneously.
