Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal, amend and re-enact Section 4, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January Session, 1854, chapter 85, entitled an Act to incorporate a company to erect a bridge over the Patuxent river, between Anne Arundel and Prince George's counties,
