Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 199, of the Acts, passed January, Session, 1874, entitled an Act to authorize the construction of fire proof vaults in the Court-House in Easton, and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof.

The bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Parkton and Manchester Railroad Company, by providing that jurors selected to condemn private property for the location of the Parkton and Manchester Railroad shall take into consideration benefits to be derived by owners of property so condemned as well as damages,
