Mr. Clark, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported without amendment,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize, empower and direct the County Commissioners of Howard county, to adjust and pay Thomas J. White, for damages occasioned by opening a public road through his lands.

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Jones, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported without amendment,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal the Act of 1874, chapter 338, entitled an Act for the taxation of Dogs, in Montgomery county,

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Hodges, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 79, sub-section 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "County Commissioners," as repealed, amended, re-enacted and added by chapter 485, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1874, and to amend and re-enact said Section 79, and sub-section 2.

Which was read a first time.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled an Act to regulate the levy for State purposes for the year 1876, and for subsequent years.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 37, of Article 75, Maryland Code of Public General Laws title "Pleadings,
