Amend Section 6, line 11, by adding the above.

Mr. Constable submitted the following amendment:

Strike out the words "1st Tuesday after the State election," in the 2nd line of the 1st Section, and insert the words, "the 1st Monday in September" in lieu thereof.

Strike out the word "December," in 2nd line of Section 3,

and insert "October," in lieu thereof.
