AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In Section 12, line 12, strike out the word "one" and insert the word "two."

Amend Section 12, by adding thereto the words "provided that all real estate sales made by said Sheriff, shall be reported to and ratified by the Circuit Court of said county."

Strike out in Section 4, line 20, after the words "paid over," to the word "discretion," in line 23.
