AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend by adding to Section 1 of bill, extending charter of the Franklin Bank the words, following, namely, "but the stockholders of said bank shall be liable to the amount of their respective share or shares of stock for all its debts and liabilities upon note, bill or otherwise."
