Also,

House bill entitled an Act to prohibit the granting of license, for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, at or near Mount Vernon Factories, in Baltimore county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act to require all auctioneers making sales in Baltimore county, to pay a license fee;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Also,

House bill entitled a further supplement to an Act passed at December Session, 1825, entitled an Act to incorporate the President and Directors of the Firemens' Insurance Company of Baltimore city, and the several supplements thereto,

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to prohibit the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Baltimore county from issuing license to vendors of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, in the village of Warren Factory, or at any place nearer than one mile in every other direction.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

On motion by Mr. Hepbron, it was

Ordered to be entered on the Journal, that Mr. Bannon is absent from his seat in the Senate, on account of the death of a friend.

On motion by Mr. Lloyd,

The vote by which Senate bill entitled an Act to add certain additional sections to Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Revenue and Taxes," providing for the assessment of property heretofore or hereafter omitted, to be assessed, and for the collection of State taxes payable thereon.
