the creation and regulation of incorporated Companies in the State of Maryland," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

By Mr. Brewer,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary, (hereafter to be appointed,) to introduce a bill to repeal Sections 48 and 49 of Article 5, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Appeals," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

By Mr. Stevens,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore city Senators to introduce a bill entitled an Act to authorize and direct the Governor to convey a lot or parcel of ground in the City of Baltimore, belonging to the State, to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

By Mr. Getty,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Getty, Ford and Lawrence to introduce a bill for the protection of deer in Garrett county.
