House bill entitled a supplement to an Act, passed at the January Session, 1860, chapter 267, entitled "An Act incorporating a company to open in part and improve the road from Frederick City, in Frederick county, to the Spout Spring on the Hamburg Road passing Bradrups Saw Mill."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
