The question recurring upon the adoption of the unfavorable report of the Committee on Judicial Proceedings on said bill.

It was adopted.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 935, Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore,

Being upon its third reading,

Mr. Stevens submitted the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In the first line of the title strike out the words "and reenact with amendments."

In the second line of the title, after the word "five," insert the words "of Article 4, of the code of"

In the same line, after the word "Baltimore," insert the words "sub-title Water," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

In Section 1, line 1, after the word "five," insert the words "of Article 4"

In Section 1, line 2, after the word "the," insert the words "Code of."

In Section 1, line 2, after the word "Baltimore," insert the words "sub-title Water."

Which were adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the third time and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:
