Mr. Stevens, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend Art. 37, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Evidence," by adding thereto certain additional Sections under the sub-title "Senate and House of Delegates," giving power to certain officers and persons in the Senate and House of Delegates of this State, to administer oaths to witnesses, and to compel the giving of testimony, and production of evidence in certain cases.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed at the Session of 1870, chapter 148, entitled an Act to add additional Sections to the Act of 1865, chapter 36, entitled an Act to incorporate the German Fire Insurance Company, of Baltimore, and also to repeal Sections 2, 3 and 6, of the said Act of 1865, chapter 36, entitled "an Act to incorporate the German Fire Insurance Company, of Baltimore," and to re-enact said Section 3, with amendments.
