Senate bill entitled an Act to amend Article 67, of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "Notaries Public," by repealing the first Section thereof and re-enacting the said Section with amendments, increasing the number of Notaries Public in the City of Baltimore, and by adding to said Article an additional Section, giving Notaries Public power to take the acknowledgments of deeds, bills of sales, mortgages or other writings required to be recorded, and to administer any oaths or affirmations required by law to be made to or concerning the same.
