Section — *And be it enacted*, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Which was adopted.

Said bill as amended, was then read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act, declaratory of the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed January Session, 1853, chapter 109, entitled "an Act to amend an Act, entitled an Act to incorporate the Fremont Savings Institution of Baltimore," by allowing said Institution the privilege embraced under the Act entitled an Act to continue the corporate existence of the several Banking Institutions therein mentioned passed at January Session, 1853, chapter 441, and to extend the corporate existence of the People's Bank of Baltimore.
