Also, by Mr. Getty,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill to amend the Act of 1853, chapter 88, entitled an Act to incorporate the Pittsburg and Connellsville Railroad Company.

On motion by Mr. Knight,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to regulate the catching, and to provide for the preservation of fish in the waters of the State and of the Potomac river.

#### AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 111, 112 and 113, of Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Meridian Line Standard," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:
