House bill entitled an Act to repeal Sections 459, 464, 469, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Live Stock," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to regulate the Liquor Traffic, and prevent intemperance in Baltimore county.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 3, of chapter 429, of the Act of 1870, dividing the 3rd District of Baltimore county into election precincts, and re-enacting the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act relating to the Franklin Bank of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

House bill entitled an Act regulating and making lawful the setting of Pound Nets in the waters of the Elk, Sassafras and Bohemia rivers, and their tributaries in Cecil county.
