

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 2, after the word "enacted," add the following: "And said Board of County Commissioners shall meet as often as necessary, from the first day of January until the annual levy shall be made, but shall not meet after said levy and until the first day of January next succeeding, except in the first Tuesday of each month."

"Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage."
