NIGHT SESSION.

TUESDAY, March 14th, 1876.

Senate met at 8 P. M.

Present at roll call the following Senators:

The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and delivered the following bills:

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Cecil county to fund certain indebtedness of the Board of County School Commissioners of Cecil county, by issuing bonds therefor, and to levy a tax for the payment of the same.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Knight, Brewer and Lee.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to construct a bridge over Beard's Creek, in said county, and to levy a sum of money for said purpose.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bannon, Hepbron and Dennis.

Senate bill entitled an Act to prevent stock running at large in Baltimore county, within fifteen miles from Baltimore city.
